Call for Candidates for President

Pursuant to Article V, Section 1 of the By Laws of the Day of Portugal and Portuguese Heritage in Rhode Island, Inc. d/b/a RI Day of Portugal, the Board of Directors will publish a call for candidates for the office of President of the Organizing Committee for the following fiscal year.

Requirements:

- ❖ Candidates must be in good standing within the community and possess strong leadership abilities;
- ❖ Submit a letter of intent to the Board of Directors including the following:
 - Leadership experience in an organization or employment
 - Vision for plans implemented during tenure as president;
- ❖ Letters of intent must be postmarked no later than June 30 prior to the year of service.

The letters of all candidates will be presented before the RI DOP Board of Directors for consideration and a decision will be made as soon as possible.

The successful candidate will be responsible for selecting his/her organizing committee, i.e. Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer as well as all other officers and event coordinators for the term. He/she will also be responsible for presiding over the Organizing Committee meetings typically held on the 1st Thursday of every month as soon as the selection is made and the General Assembly meeting which is held on the 3rd Thursday of every month beginning in January through the month of June.

The Portuguese Heritage Festival and Parade celebration takes place on the weekend closest to June 10th of any given year. Candidates are expected to be available for that weekend as well as other activities throughout the year.
